

Directions to Hope Cottage

From M25 Junction 7

Head South on M23 (S) signposted Gatwick/Brighton and stay on this road for 22 miles (the road name changes to A23).

Take slip road left to A272 towards Petersfield / Haywards Heath. Take fourth Exit from the roundabout to Cowfold/Petersfield and stay on A272 for 4 miles until you reach Cowfold.

Turn left at the first roundabout onto A281 - travel 5.5 miles south to Henfield.

As you approach Henfield High Street, look for the White Hart pub on the left and the Bell Inn on the right. Turn right opposite the White Hart into Church Street. Continue along this road, going over two mini roundabouts (road changes into Upper Station Road). Hope Cottage is on this road, one mile from this point. Continue past The Cat and Canary Pub on the right (road changes into West End Lane). Continue past a row of houses on the left and the road turns into a single track lane. Go past a large converted barn on the left (Lancasters Barn) and take the next driveway on the left to Lancasters. Hope Cottage on the left as you enter the drive.

From The South A27/ A259

Follow A283 North to Steyning/Henfield. At roundabout take the second exit and at the following roundabout turn right onto the A2037 Henfield Road to Henfield . Follow this road for 5 miles. On approaching Henfield go straight over roundabout into Henfield High Street.

Proceed along the High Street until you reach the White Hart pub on the right and the Bell Inn on the Left. Turn left opposite the White Hart into Church Street. Continue along this road, going over two mini roundabouts (road changes into Upper Station Road). Hope Cottage is on this road, one mile from this point. Continue past The Cat and Canary Pub on the right (road changes into West End Lane). Continue past a row of houses on the left and the road turns into a single track lane. Go past a large converted barn on the left (Lancasters Barn) and take the next driveway on the left to Lancasters. Hope Cottage on the left as you enter the drive.
